

- I. Love Demonstrated (Rom. 8:31-34).**
 - A. God demonstrates his love for us by having a redemptive plan for us (see Rom. 8:30).**
 - B. Because God is for us we need not fear those who are against us (v.31)**
 - 1. The world hates us (see John 15:18,19) and the devil, the prince of this world (see John 16:11 and 1 John 5:19), hates us (see 1 Pet. 5:8).**
 - 2. Thank God we have a friend in Jesus who is greater than the world and the devil (see 1 John 4:4).**
 - C. God demonstrated his love for us by sending his Son, the Lord Jesus Christ, to this planet to die for our sin (v.32; see John 15:13 and 1 John 2:2).**
 - D. God demonstrates his love for us by graciously giving us everything we need (v.32; see Phil. 4:19 and Matt. 6:33).**
 - E. God demonstrates his love for us by justifying us (v.33,34).**
 - F. God demonstrates his love for us by giving us a heavenly intercessor, the Lord Jesus Christ (v.34).**

- II. Love Unchangeable (Romans 8:38,39).**
 - A. God's love for us does not and will not change; God has loved, loves, and will love us, no matter what.**
 - B. Nothing can destroy the love that God has for us.**

- III. The Importance of Abiding in Christ (Rom. 8:35-37).**
 - A. If we abide (remain) in Christ – if we continue to trust in and live for him – nothing can destroy the love that we have for him.**
 - B. As followers of Christ we are more than conquerors (v.37).**
 - C. In and through Christ we can triumphantly overcome all things (v.35,36).**
 - D. Endure ...persevere ...abide in Christ ...trust and obey him, no matter what, and one day you will reign with him in glory (see 2 Tim. 2:12)!**
